Applicants must apply in person and may not apply without the required documents listed below.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicant must be at least 18 years of age. Applicants must provide copies of the following documents when applying. **Please note, the copies you provide will not be returned.**
 - A valid Driver License or Valid State issued identification card
 - Birth Certificate
 - Social Security Card
 - Proof of High School Diploma or Legal equivalent is also required: High School Diploma, or G.E.D. or Official sealed Transcripts
 - DD 214 Military Discharge (if applicable)
2. Applicant must be physically able to perform the work of the trade.

TESTING:

Upon completion of application, providing all the above documentation is present and applicable, you will be scheduled and notified to take a two-part written exam: Math (Numerical Ability) and Mechanical Aptitude. Applicants who pass the written exam with a minimum total score of 70 percent will be scheduled for an oral interview.

INTERVIEW:

Applicants passing the written exam will be scheduled for an interview with the Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee.

LENGTH OF TRAINING: A minimum of five (5) years of Schooling & five (5) years of on-the-job Training
